#### **RESOLUTION No. 15-19**

#### Adopted April 17, 2019

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT IT IS DESIRABLE FOR THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY OF CHESTER FOR THE CHESTER COUNTY HEALTH AND EDUCATION FACILITIES AUTHORITY TO UNDERTAKE A PROJECT INVOLVING THE ISSUANCE OF CHESTER COUNTY HEALTH AND EDUCATION FACILITIES AUTHORITY HEALTH SYSTEM REVENUE BONDS (MAIN LINE HEALTH SYSTEM), SERIES 2019 AND TO UNDERTAKE OTHER PROJECTS INVOLVING MAIN LINE HEALTH SYSTEM; APPROVING THE PROJECT UNDER SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED; AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS.

The following recitals are a part of this Resolution.

- A. Main Line Health System (the "Corporation") has requested the Chester County Health and Education Facilities Authority (the "Authority") to approve a financing which will include, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipality Authorities Act, Act 22 of 2001, 53 Pa.C.S. §5601 et seq., as amended (the "Authorities Act"), the issuance of the Authority's Health System Revenue Bonds (Main Line Health System), Series 2019, in one or more series, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$80,000,000 (collectively, the "2019 Bonds").
- B. The Corporation has asked the Authority to finance, together with other available funds of the Corporation, the costs of a project (the "Project") consisting generally of the: (i) financing of a portion of the costs of acquiring, renovating, equipping and improving an administration building for health-related services located in Delaware County at 240 North Radnor Chester Road, Radnor, Pennsylvania; (ii) refunding of a portion of the Authority's Health System Revenue Bonds (Jefferson Health System), Series 2010A; and (iii) payment of the costs of issuance of the 2019 Bonds.
- C. The Authorities Act authorizes the financing of the Project for the Corporation and with respect to the Project, and certain other projects, requires that "each municipality organizing an Authority... shall declare by resolution or ordinance that it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the people in the area served by such facilities to have such facilities... financed through (the) Authority." 53 P.S. §5607(B)(2)(IV).
- D. Pursuant to the Authorities Act, the Corporation and the Authority have requested the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Chester, Pennsylvania (the "Board of County Commissioners") to declare, by this resolution, that the Project is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the people in the area served by the Corporation.

- E. Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, 26 U.S.C. §147(f) (the "Code"), requires that the applicable elected representatives of the governmental unit on behalf of which bonds are issued and of each governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which any facility is located, approve bonds after a public hearing in order for a private activity bond to be a qualified bond under the Code.
- F. The Board of County Commissioners constitutes the appropriate elected representatives for the purposes of giving Section 147(f) approvals.
- G. On April 8, 2019, the Authority held a hearing in compliance with Section 147(f) pursuant to public notice.
  - H. The Authority approved the Project and the 2019 Bonds on April 8, 2019.

Pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Code, the Corporation and the Authority have requested the Board of County Commissioners to approve the issuance of the 2019 Bonds.

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Chester, Pennsylvania as follows:
- <u>SECTION 1</u>. It is hereby determined and declared pursuant to the Authorities Act that it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the people in the area served by the Corporation for the Authority to undertake the financing of the Project through the issuance of the 2019 Bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$80,000,000.
- <u>SECTION 2</u>. The issuance of the 2019 Bonds and the financing of the Project are hereby approved.
- <u>SECTION 3</u>. The foregoing determination, declaration and approval are for the purposes of the applicable provisions of the Authorities Act and the Code and do not constitute approval for any permit, license or zoning required for the construction or occupancy of any facilities to be financed or refinanced as part of the Project.
- <u>SECTION 4</u>. The adoption of this Resolution is not a pledge of any revenues or security by the County of Chester. Neither the credit nor the taxing power of the County of Chester, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or any political subdivision, agency or instrumentality thereof is pledged for payment of the 2019 Bonds.
- <u>SECTION 5</u>. All actions of this Board of County Commissioners taken in conformity with the intents and purposes of this Resolution are ratified, confirmed and approved in all respects.
- <u>SECTION 6</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately. All prior ordinances or resolutions or portions thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**WHEREAS**, the Chester County Commissioners, pursuant to the authority provided under the County Code, specifically 16 P.S. §1701 and 1801, are vested with and otherwise are responsible for the management and administration of County fiscal affairs and are the sole contractors for the County; and

**WHEREAS**, on some occasions, largely dependent upon statute, rule, regulation or by administrative necessity, it is required or otherwise beneficial for the Commissioners to delegate and authorize County Department heads and authorized designees with the authority to execute documents in furtherance and effectuation of certain programs, initiatives, grant and/or contractual obligations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chester County Planning Commission participates in the procurement of certain Commonwealth and Federal grants which requires the execution of documentation in furtherance of seeking said grants; and

**WHEREAS**, certain Commonwealth agencies, as well as Federal agencies, have indicated that each will be requiring County submission/approval of grants through the Commonwealth eGrants system and Grants.gov system to be made electronically and as a result must be executed electronically; and

**WHEREAS**, these governmental entities have indicated that each will accept a delegation of signatory authority involving said grant applications and permit the execution of said grant applications by, in this case, the Executive Director of the Chester County Planning Commission or approved designee;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Chester County Commissioners, that the Executive Director of the Chester County Planning Commission, and/or an authorized designee, are hereby authorized to electronically execute any Commonwealth and Federal Grant application documents as required in the furtherance of securing certain grants on behalf of the County of Chester, Pennsylvania.
