#### Employment after Retirement – 40207 (REVISED 5/31/22)

A County retiree who has started receiving their pension may work for any employer other than the County and still receive their full pension allowance.

A County retiree who is subsequently re-employed by the County on a part-time basis who works less than 1,000 hours in a 12-month period, based on their date of hire as a part-time employee, will still receive their full pension allowance. If the <u>individual</u> works more than 1,000 hours as a part-time employee for the County, their monthly pension will be reduced (*Please refer to Chester County Employees' Retirement System Summary Plan Description for more information*). While the individual is employed in a part-time status as a retiree, they will not receive additional service credit for retirement purposes. Part-time employees are different than retirees who return in a part-time status.

If a County retiree is subsequently re-employed by the County on a full-time basis, the individual's retirement allowance shall immediately cease. Upon subsequent retirement, the individual's retirement allowance will be recalculated.

Service as a juror, master, or arbitrator while as a retiree shall not be considered "reemployment" and the individual's pension shall not be affected by such service.

Nothing in this policy creates a right to rehire for any retiree.
