Introduction

On December 14, 2015, Internal Audit completed an audit of the *Pocopson Home Guest Fund (Guest Fund)*. Christian J. Kriza was the auditor-in-charge and was assisted by one other auditor. Internal Audit is required by the Pennsylvania County Code to review county offices annually to ensure compliance with policies and procedures and to assess their overall internal control structure. The scope of our audit included a review of the following:

- Cash and Petty Cash
- Cash Receipts
- Cash Disbursements
- Voided Transactions
- Overall Compliance

We conducted our audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards and standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards* published by the Comptroller of the United States. We have also issued our Independent Auditor's Report on Internal Control over Financial Reporting and on Compliance and Other Matters concurrent with this Management Letter. Disclosures and other information in that Report (also dated December 14, 2015) should be considered in conjunction with this Management Letter.

Executive Summary

The management and staff of the *Guest Fund* are in all material respects, in compliance with policies and procedures imposed by the County of Chester and by the *Guest Fund*. There were no matters of a significant nature related to internal controls or overall compliance noted during this audit. However, a minor finding involving procedural controls and recordkeeping is included in this management letter.

The management and staff of the *Guest Fund* should be commended for their dedication to excellence. Internal Audit offers its compliments to an extremely knowledgeable and well-trained staff.

Cash and Petty Cash

Cash is reconciled and reviewed at 100%. Petty cash is counted during the course of the on-site fieldwork.

There were no internal control or procedural weaknesses noted.

Personal Needs Income

Personal Needs Income is reconciled and reviewed at 100%.

Finding 1: Personal Needs Income

In five (5) instances, a Personal Needs Income account had a negative balance and was not researched/remedied in a timely manner. These items have since been cleared.

Recommendation

Internal Audit recommends that the Personal Needs Income accounts are reviewed on a monthly, or at minimum, a quarterly basis, to ensure that items are remedied in a timely manner.

Auditee Response

Pocopson Home Management concurs with the audit findings and recommendations.

For the following areas, transactions are reviewed on a sample basis according to risk. The current year risk assessment is based on prior year audit results:

Cash Receipts

The sample size tested for the year ended 12/31/14 was 20 out of a population of 79 receipts generated in 2014.

There were no internal control or procedural weaknesses noted within our sample.

Cash Disbursements

The sample size tested for the year ended 12/31/14 was 20 out of a population of 1,663 disbursements generated in 2014.

Disbursements:

The sample size tested for the year ended 12/31/14 was 10 out of a population of 18 disbursements voided in 2014.

Compliance

The sample size tested for the year ended 12/31/14 was 10 out of a population of 260 cases available in 2014.

There were no internal control or procedural weaknesses noted within our sample.
