

“Extra Help” Program

Do You Have Medicare?

The “Extra Help” Program is offered to Medicare recipients and can:

- ◆ Lower prescription copayments and premiums
- ◆ Eliminate the coverage gap (donut hole)

Eligibility for **Single Person, Partial Subsidy:**

Total monthly income of less than **\$1,610** per month;
and less than **\$13,290** in resources.

All incomes should add \$20/mo disregard
Add \$1500 per person burial allowance to resource totals

Eligibility for **Couple, Partial Subsidy:**

Total monthly income of less than **\$2,178** per month;
and less than **\$26,520** in resources.

Low-Income Premium Subsidy
for 2021 in PA is **\$37.45**

2021 PACE Part D Partner

Medicare Savings Programs (Form-PA 600 M)

- ◆ QMB (Qualified Medicare Beneficiary): Parts A/B premiums, Medicare deductibles and copayments are paid for by the State of PA. Eliminates Parts A/B Late Enrollment Penalties (LEP).
- ◆ SLMB (Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary): the State of PA pays the Part B premium only. Eliminates Part B LEP.
- ◆ QI-1 (Qualifying Individual): the State of PA pays the Part B premium only. Eliminates Part B LEP.

Healthy Horizons

Medicaid For those with Medicare (Form-PA 600)

Online: www.compass.state.pa.us

- ◆ Available to individuals with low income and resources.
- ◆ An ACCESS card is issued by the State of PA to be used for medical services at participating doctors' offices, hospitals, and other providers.

What it pays

- ◆ Medicare premiums, deductibles, copayments, coinsurances for Part A and Part B.
- ◆ Assistance with Medicare prescription drug plan costs and copayments.

PACE/PACENET

PACE/PACENET will help reduce the cost of your prescription medications. You can be enrolled in PACE/PACENET and some other prescription plans at the same time.

Eligibility Requirements

- ◆ 65 years of age or older.
- ◆ Pennsylvania resident for at least 90 days.
- ◆ Meet the income limits listed below (assets are not counted as income).
- ◆ Income is based on prior calendar year.
- ◆ As of February 7, 2014, Medicare Part B Premiums are no longer counted as income.
