



County Office Discount Policy
Revised March 21, 2019 and made effective on April 29, 2019

On April 16, 2009, the Chester County Conservation District Board of Directors approved the collection of a District Service Fee for the Erosion and Sedimentation Pollution Control and NPDES Program for county projects.

Fees are based on the disturbed acreage of the project rounded up to the nearest whole number.

The following is the approved schedule:

<u>Disturbed Acreage</u>	<u>Fee</u>
0 - <5 acres	\$ 250
5 - <10 acres	\$ 500
10 acres and above	\$1,000

For miscellaneous projects (Timber Harvest, Chapter 105, Pond/Stream, and Small Agricultural Building Projects), the regular District Service Fee will be charged if less than the County Offices Fee listed above.

A check payable to the Chester County Conservation District must be included for the appropriate amount when submitting a plan to the Conservation District for review. If the disturbed acreage is 1 acre or more, a fee of \$500 for a General NPDES permit or \$1,500 for an Individual NPDES permit continues to be required and is payable to the Chester County Conservation District Clean Water Fund. In addition, there is a DEP disturbed acreage fee of \$100 per disturbed acre rounded to the nearest whole number due and payable to the Commonwealth of PA Clean Water Fund. Please refer to the District Services Fee Schedule for more information on permit fees.
