SUBJECT: Emergency Absentee Ballot Walk-ins

Voters requesting an Emergency Absentee Ballot for the Tuesday, Nov 5, 2019 MUNICIPAL ELECTION should call 610-344-6429. All "Emergency Absentee Ballot Applications" **must be notarized and will need to be approved by a Common Pleas Court Judge.**

**Between 5:00 P.M. on Friday, Nov 1, 2019 through 8:00 P.M. on Tuesday, Nov 5, 2019** a qualified registered voter in Chester County may obtain an **Emergency Absentee Ballot** by first calling the following number: **610-344-6429.**

**In order to qualify for an Emergency Absentee Ballot a voter must meet the following criteria:**

1. Be legally entitled to vote on Tuesday, Nov 5, 2019  
**and**  
**Became ill or disabled after 5:00 P.M. on Friday, Nov 1, 2019,** and due to such illness or disability cannot go to the voter's designated polling place,  
  
**OR**
2. Be legally entitled to vote on Tuesday, Nov 5, 2019  
**and**  
**Found out after 5:00 P.M. on Friday, Nov 1, 2019 that because of the conduct of the voter's business duties or occupation,** the voter will necessarily be **absent** from the municipality of the voter's residence on Tuesday, Nov 5, 2019.

You will need to first meet with the Director of Voter Services at the office of Voter Services (601 Westtown Road, Suite 150, West Chester, PA 19380) before meeting with the Court of Common Pleas Judge and executing the ballot. This process cannot be handled remotely.
