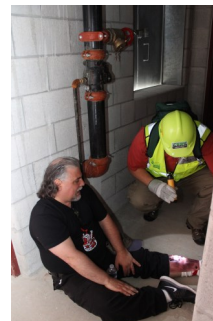
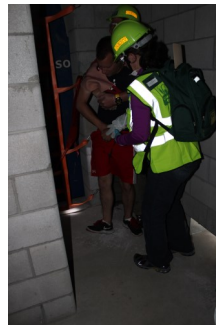
### Course Description:
