



CORONAVIRUS COVID-19

Long Term Care Facilities and Personal Care Homes

Given their congregate nature and resident population served (e.g., older adults often with underlying chronic medical conditions), our long term care facilities and personal care homes are at the highest risk of being affected by COVID-19. The Chester County Health Department assists these facilities and homes to identify cases, review practices, and manage the spread of COVID-19. A facility or home with one (1) positive case is considered to have an outbreak.

Long term care facilities and personal care homes (LTC/PCH) are licensed by the Pennsylvania Department of Health or Pennsylvania Department of Human Services. Please note that death data provided below is regardless of the residents' county of residence.
