TESTING FOR CORONAVIRUS IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS

Because your body takes days to weeks to make antibodies, the antibody test is not helpful to decide if you have COVID-19 right now. People with symptoms who might have COVID-19 may need a different test, usually a nose swab.

WHEN TO SEEK EMERGENCY CARE

If you are experiencing **serious symptoms** or a **medical emergency**, call 9-1-1.

Call ahead to the emergency department or tell the 9-1-1 operator about your symptoms and any COVID-19 exposure.

Serious Symptoms Include:

- New confusion
- Unable to wake-up or be fully alert
- Bluish lips or face
- Severe shortness of breath
- Severe pain or pressure in the chest

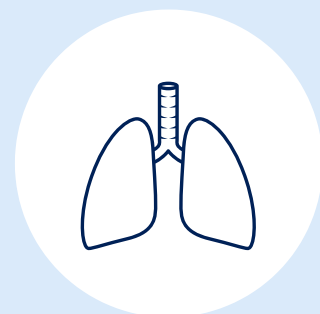
