IN RE: LIFTING OF RESTRICTIONS RELATED TO COVID-19

## **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 7-2021**

AND NOW, this 27th day of May, 2021, in consideration of Governor Wolf's May 4, 2021 announcement that all COVID-19 restrictions related to gatherings, restaurants, and other businesses in Pennsylvania will be lifted as of May 31, 2021, and the updated CDC recommendations regarding the wearing of masks for fully vaccinated people, adopted by the Pennsylvania Acting Secretary of Health per amended order of March 16, 2021, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that all prior administrative orders presently in place regarding COVID-19 protocols are rescinded as of June 1, 2021.

Individuals who are not fully vaccinated need to continue following Pennsylvania Department of Health and CDC guidance as it pertains to mask wearing.

All common pleas judges, magisterial district judges as well as court department heads may continue to utilize certain COVID-19 related protocols (such as the use of advanced communication technology) in accordance with their discretion, if deemed useful in promoting the efficiency of court related operations.
