



Chester County COVID-19 Monitoring Report

Most Current 7 Days: 02/25/2022 – 03/03/2022

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Introduction

The data provided below are used to monitor the impact of COVID-19 in Chester County. Data is updated once a week.

Community Level

As of March 4, 2022, Chester County has transitioned to using COVID-19 Community Levels to monitor the overall impact of COVID-19 in our county. Community Levels are determined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) using three measures – new COVID-19 admissions per 100,000 population in the past 7 days, the percent of staffed inpatient beds occupied by COVID-19 patients, and total new COVID-19 cases per 100,000 population in the past 7 days. New COVID-19 admissions and the percent of staffed inpatient beds occupied represent the current potential for strain on the health system. Data on new cases acts as an early warning indicator of potential increases in health system strain in the event of a COVID-19 surge.
