

EnviroScape Watershed/NonPoint Source Model



What happens when it rains? This popular model demonstrates pollution and stormwater runoff and its prevention in your watershed, focusing on residential, industry, forestry, transportation, recreation, agricultural, and construction environments. The model shows how rain carries soil (represented by cocoa), chemicals (drink mixes) and oil (cocoa mixture) through the watershed to a pond, lake, river, bay, or ocean. The model can also be used to demonstrate best management practices to prevent pollution.
